TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

In the South Pacific Islands the drier months are from April to October. This time of the year enjoys less humidity and pleasant temperatures for lounging on the beach, snorkelling, diving and hiking. The waters of the South Pacific are a snorkellers dream where you can find whales, turtles and a kaleidoscope of colourful fish. Keep an eye out for the majestic humpback whales as they make an amazing journey to the Cook Islands waters to breed and calve from July through to October. Temperatures in the South Pacific Islands are constant year-round, whilst the warmer months of November to March can bring tropical showers and storms. During the green season, get off the beaten path and see the many spectacular waterfalls in full flow.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

A valid passport is required with at least six months validity beyond the date of departure from Australia. For the Cook Islands and Samoa, a visa is not required for stays of up to 30 days. You will need to apply for a tourist visa to enter Vanuatu when you arrive at the airport, which allows you to stay up to 120 days. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas, and other information for the countries you intend visiting from the Australian Government at smarttraveller.gov.au.

TIME

The Cook Islands are 20 hours behind Australian Eastern Standard time (AEST). Vanuatu is one hour ahead of AEST and Samoa is three hours ahead of AEST. Daylight Saving Time is observed in Australia from September to March where clocks are turned forward by one hour.

Cook Islands, Samoa, Vanuatu: 240V 50Hz. An adapter is required.

CURRENCY

The New Zealand dollar is the official unit of currency in the Cook Islands. ATMs are in abundance in Rarotonga and a couple can be found in Aitutaki. In Samoa the local currency is Samoan Tala and in Vanuatu the Vanuatu Vata. ATMs can be found throughout Samoa generally only in Urban areas. Beyond Port Vila and Luganville in Vanuatu there are very few ATMs. It is always a good idea to carry some local cash on you in all three countries, as not all venues have card payment facilities.

TIPPING & BARGAINING

In The Cook Islands, Vanuatu and Samoa, tipping is not practised or expected, however leaving a small monetary gift for good service will be welcomed.

LANGUAGE

Cook Islands: Cook Islands Mauri is the native language.

Samoa: Samoan is the official language.

Vanuatu: French and Bislama (Pidgin English) are both spoken.

English is widely spoken throughout all islands and is used in hotels and restaurants.

Open on Saturday mornings discover fresh fruit, island food, coffee, handmade ukeleles, handicrafts, black pearls and more.

There are countless numbers of smaller islands peppered throughout the South Pacific. For a relaxing day out, why not head out to Fafa Island in Samoa where you can have a picnic and relax under a fale on a stretch of white sand beach. In Vanuatu, try Lelepa and Pele Island. A day trip from Rarotonga to Aitutaki is a must for travellers not planning to stay in Aitutaki whilst in the Cook Islands. Aitutaki is known to be home to the world's most beautiful and pristine lagoon.

SNORKELLING & DIVING

Snorkel and dive in the crystal-clear waters of the South Pacific and discover incredible, colourful coral reefs bursting with captivating marine life. WHALE WATCHING

Between the months of July and October Humpback whales arrive in the Cook Islands waters as they migrate into the South Pacific from their Summer feeding grounds of Australia and New Zealand. The migration patterns of these miraculous giants varies each year, but they can be seen throughout these months. Known for their breathtaking breaches and hauntingly beautiful songs, the western side of Rarotonga is the best place for whale spotting. In Aitutaki the best way to see them is to dive with them. Seeing the whales as they play is a magical experience.

SURFING

There are few experiences as exhilarating as surfing in the crystal-clear waters of the South Pacific Islands. Surfing the South Pacific is not for beginners – here you'll find some of the most challenging reef breaks with powerful waves and hollow barrels.
